We can do this by traveling to meet together and pray before our Lord. The Holy Hour happens every third Thursday of the month and is held at one location per deanery (local 8 churches). This week it is at Saint Joseph Parish, Pewamo 126 East St. Pewamo, MI 48873 at 6pm on the 21st. While the Knights are coordinating this initiative it is meant for all.

I did some reflecting while Fr. Bauer was talking about it to a group of us last weekend, thinking about the impact this might have on a young boy or girl whose family participated and saw members of his/her parish there. We rearrange our days to get them to practices and after school clubs, we travel to distant towns to watch their games, and many of us make plans in advance to make sure we can watch our favorite sports team. No wonder many say they want to be athletes when they grow up. Making Mass every week a priority is of course the most important part of showing how important our Faith is to us, but seeing people from all over the diocese travel to pray for more people to accept a vocation might help touch some hearts and instill that feeling of just how important a future with priests and religious is to all of us.
